Women's AA Meetings

- 1. Wednesdays at 6:30 pm to 7:30 pm
- 2. Saturdays at 7:00 pm to 8:00 pm

Open AA Meeting Rules & Requirements as of 6/1/2021:

- 1. Requirements are subject to change due to City of Savannah and CDC guidelines. Any visitor on Recovery Place property is required to wear a mask unless he/she is vaccinated. We ask that visitors have proof that they are vaccinated and show it to staff when asked.
- 2. Please arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to the meeting unless you have been approved for a visit.
- 3. When you enter the building please let the receptionist know that you are there to attend the AA meeting. She will direct you to the location where the meeting will be held. The meeting place may either be inside the building or outside.
- 4. After the meeting is finished, we ask that male visitors go across the street to smoke and visit after meetings. We ask that female visitors stay in the meeting room/area to visit and do not go to the smoking area.
- 5. Due to client confidentiality, only members of AA are allowed to attend this meeting. No family members, children, or pets are allowed. Service animals are allowed.
- 6. We ask that Recovery Place clients be allowed to participate in the meetings.
- 7. Please do not bring any items, unless it is recovery literature, to give to clients without getting it approved by Recovery Place staff. This includes cell phones, notes or letters, cigarettes, money, clothing, and food.
- 8. The following items are not allowed to be used at the facility:
 - a. Cell phones
 - b. Electronic devices
 - c. E-cigarettes/vapes
 - d. Cigars
 - e. Food and beverages including water
- 9. Smoking is allowed only at designated smoking areas.
- 10. When staff notices any violation of these requirements, they will redirect the individual(s). Failure to respond to the request or being rude will result in the individual being asked to leave the property. If this occurs three or more times, the individual will be banned from Recovery Place AA meetings until they meet with the Clinical Director.
